**4 events have been carried out within this project:**

**Event 1**

**Participation:** The event involved **32** citizens, including **22** participants from the city of Palermo (**Italy**), **4** participants from the city of Struga (**North Macedonia**), **3** participants from the city of Shibenik (**Croatia**), **3** participants from the city of Madrid (**Spain**).

**Location/ Dates:** The event took place in Aula Magna University of Palermo (**Palermo, Italy**), from 08/09/2021 to 10/09/2021

**Short description:** The aim of the event was to assess the needs of the citizens and citizens services. This event (community forum) gathered local citizens and representatives from the other participating countries, in order to discuss the needs and the issues the marginalized communities in Europe are facing, and to give feedback and recommendations on what should be done.

**Event 2**

**Participation:** The event involved **32** citizens, including **22** participants from the city of Madrid (**Spain**), **4** participants from the city of Struga (**North Macedonia**), **3** participants from the city of Shibenik (**Croatia**), **3** participants from the city of Palermo (**Italy**).

**Location/ Dates:** The event took place in C.C. Vinagrande Alcoron (**Madrid, Spain**), from 06/10/2021 to 08/10/2022

**Short description:** The aim of the event was focused on explaining how SOLIDARITY and civic actions and organizations can be a tool (solution) for making a social impact. Based on the recommendations from the Italian Community Forum, on the Public Debate the participants will discuss the civic opportunities, in order to stimulate European solidarity such as volunteering, donations, foundations, civil society organizations, charities, crowdfunding, etc, as a tool for improving the lives of marginalized communities.

**Event 3**

**Participation:** The event involved **28** citizens, including **13** participants from the city of Shibenik (**Croatia**), **8** participants from the city of Struga (**North Macedonia**), **3** participants from the city of Palermo (**Italy**), **3** participants from the city of Madrid (**Spain**), **1** participant from Lisbon (**Portugal**).

**Location/ Dates:** The event took place in (**Shibenik, Croatia**) from 16/03/2022 to 18/03/2022

**Short description:** The aim of the event was giving a method for solving the needs (based on Italian and Spanish events). A training course for what social innovation is, and giving a methodology and examples of what actions can be done on a European level.

**Event 4**

**Participation:** The event involved **54** citizens, including **37** participants from the city of Struga, Ohrid, Skopje (**North Macedonia**), **5** participants from the city of Librazhd (**Albania**), **3** participants from the city of Palermo (**Italy**), **4** participants from the city of Shibenik (**Croatia**), **3** participant from Madrid (**Spain**), **2** participant from Belgrade (**Serbia**).

**Location/ Dates:** The event took place in University for Information Science and Technology "St. Paul the Apostle" (**Ohrid, North Macedonia**) from 15/06/2022 to 17/06/2022.

**Short description:** The aim of the event was to give instructions on how to use digitalization and new technologies in improvement and modernization of the civic sector, in order to increase the solidarity and make more profound social impact. The results from the researches will be presented, and based on them will be offered concrete digital solutions.
